### Getting To Know You:

1. What is something that you like that everyone else seems to dislike?
2. What is a book that you would recommend?

### Understanding the Passage:

1. Read **Matthew 21:1-11**
  - a. Does anything stand out to you in this passage?
2. What was Jesus *saying and not saying* when He rode into Jerusalem on a donkey? What is the significance of the donkey and its colt?
3. Jesus sent two disciples on a unique assignment (v.2). Has the Lord ever given you a unique assignment? What did that look like? If not, in what ways do you think he has equipped you to serve in the kingdom?
4. When Jesus entered the city, the crowds treated him like a king. What were they expecting from him? (v.9)
  - a. Jesus didn't meet their expectations, and some would call for his crucifixion later on. What are some unrealistic expectations that we sometimes have of God?
5. When Jesus approached Jerusalem on the donkey, the question circulating was, "Who is this?" (v. 10). If someone were to approach you today wanting to know "who is Jesus," what would you say?
